End of Day Collections

Could we remind all families, if someone else is collecting your child, that you inform the office before 12.45pm. We know there will be instances where this is not possible, but this will help ensure that all messages get to your child's teacher in a timely manner and the children are safely collected. Thank you.

Reporting Absence

When calling the school to report your child absent (via Option 1 on the telephone), please give sufficient detail as to the reason for absence. I.e. sickness and diarrhoea, high temperature, (rather than ill, or unwell). We have to record the reason of absence and so this will, in most instances, avoid the need for us to contact you to obtain further information. **Thank you.**

Reminders of expectations:

For safety reasons; **No hoodies or jewellery** for PE. PE T-shirts should be plain white!

When collecting children, please line up by the hedge to ensure that the paths are free for people to walk on

Please call the office to report child absence. There is a designated answer machine for absence messages

Children should be reading at least 3 times per week. This helps them attain the rewards they deserve.

Children's attendance should be above 95% - please avoid missing any days from school unless ill.
