Dear Families,

Please can you help keep our children safe by:

- Only arriving at school at your child's gate time
- Only 1 adult being with your child/children
- Waiting on the opposite side of the road if you need to wait for more than 1 gate entry.
- Leaving the gate as soon as the child is in the school's care
- Keeping social distance from staff members when talking to them.
- Only coming into the Main Reception if your queries cannot be dealt with over the telephone.
- When collecting your children can you wait as near to the hedge as possible, or on the opposite side of the road, to allow children leaving the school to be able to walk on the path.
