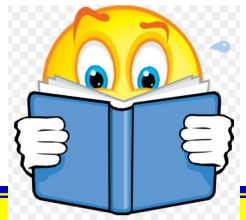

TRANSITION INFORMATION TO FOLLOW WEEK BEGINNING 6th JULY

Transition information will be posted on the website and sent with End of Year School Reports.

Dear Families,

Thank you for all of the well-wishes, notes of gratitude and support for the school and staff during this uncertain period. The school has continued to provide a safe, nurturing and engaging environment for all of the children who have returned to school. We have also continued to contact and work with all of the families that have not yet been able to return. Sadly school cannot provide spaces for Y2,3,4 or 5 children as we have to ensure spaces for EY, Y1,Y6 and Key worker children.

*As we look forward to September we understand that there are many questions. Some we can answer but some we are still waiting for further guidelines from the government. In the mean time we are hoping and planning to be fully open from the **2nd of September** with all of the children back in school, [except the new Reception class who will have a phased start.] We will keep you informed with as much information as possible as and when we find out more.*

*Teachers have missed meeting with their new classes but are really excited about spending time with the children in September. To help prepare the children teachers have created packs and presentations that will be put on the website and in the reports from the 6th of July. The **transition** information includes, class, teacher, classmates, routines, location, entrance gates etc [please note that gates and times may change if we need to continue staggered entrance to school]*

*The **reports** will include information about the children up to the end of Spring term and how the children had progressed up to that point. It will not include end of year assessment results as these have not been taken nationally due to the pandemic.*

*Teachers have also recorded **videos** of themselves reading stories and these will be posted on the website early next week. Take a look and pick your favourite.*

*Some parents have asked if there is any chance of Sports Day going ahead in some format—sadly there will **not** be any **whole school or year group activities** until further notice. We thank all those parents and families who regularly support the school events and hope to start them again as soon as we are given the opportunity.*
