## Week 8 -

Most prefixes are added to the beginning of root words without any changes in spelling, but see in- below. Like un-, the prefixes dis- and mis- have nega-tive meanings.
The prefix in- can mean both 'not' and 'in'/'into'. In the words given here it means 'not'.
Before a root word starting with I, in- becomes il
Before a root word starting with $\mathbf{m}$ or $\mathbf{p}$, in- be-comes im-.
Before a root word starting with $\mathbf{r}$, in- becomes ir-.
