Dear Families,

As you are aware we have had a positive Covid 19 case in school last week and one class has been contacted to self isolate until the 20th November. ONLY those contacted need to self isolate- all siblings and other children in the school are to attend as normal.

School continues to follow all guidelines and keeps bubbles separate. We are also reducing the risk through many other actions in school. Please continue to help by reminding children to wash their hands regularly, and cough into a tissue then throw it away. Adults can also help:

- Arrive at school on time-not early- not late
- Only one adult to bring the children
- Move away from the school gates as soon as the child is in the school's care
- Socially distance whilst waiting
- Wear a mask if you MUST visit school



**Please remember** that if **anyone** in your household is waiting for a Covid test result then the whole household **must** stay in isolation. Children **CANNOT** attend school if anyone in the household is waiting for test results.

Please contact the school if your child is off school for any reason. We complete a government survey daily to report how many children are off school due to any Covid related incidents, [symptoms, waiting test, isolation etc.]

### Remote learning



If your child is absent from school then please use the school website for their first 3 days of learning. Please go to the 'Learning' drop down and then select your child's class.

Every week the teachers upload learning and activities linked to the learning going on in school so that the children do not miss out on their learning if at home. This includes learning activities, video lessons, websites and education city links that directly link to that week's learning.

The children are practicing accessing the learning platforms in school so that they find it easy if they have to isolate at home at some point.

If your child needs to isolate, the school will also be in regular contact to check that the children are well and also that they are understanding the work set and how staff can help.

### E-school log in

To access all of the facilities on the school website and to book parent evening consultations, parents need to log into their e-school account on the website. This will also help the school get communications to you quicker and easier. We are also investigating using this as an ongoing remote learning platform to make home e-learning easier and in one place for the children.



### Parent Evenings

Although we usually have a 'settling in' open evening in October, sadly, we were not able to have them due to Covid restrictions this year.

However at the Woodlands we usually have full Parent Evenings in January and April- this falls after the termly assessments so that teachers are able to share the latest information about the children's learning, attendance and next steps.

This year due to restrictions we are unable to hold face to face meetings so teachers will be holding Parent Evening by telephone. To help manage this and distribute the telephones in school the consultations will be spread over a 2 week period. They will still be after the assessments and staff will share the latest information with you.

Ask, Oak, Willow Maple and Spruce will hold their parent evenings before Christmas

Pine, Birch, Elm, Chestnut, Aspen and Redwood will be after Christmas
